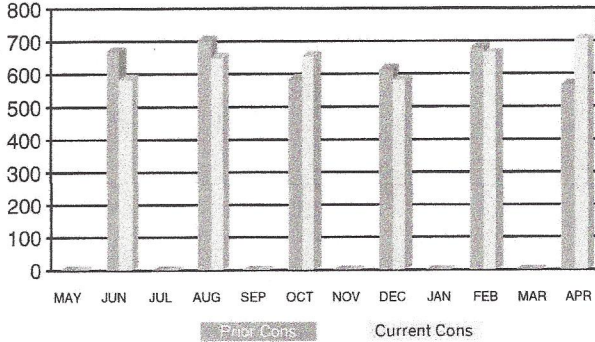
2020 Winter Averaging Rates are now in effect. Sewer charges may have increased or decreased based upon winter water consumption.

ADMINISTRATION

Dear Customer:

For the greater good, many in our community have been mandated to stop work and stay at home in order to combat the outbreak. We are seeing unprecedented numbers of residents and businesses that are taking on this loss of income and are severely limited in their ability to pay basic essential utilities.

In order to provide some short-term economic relief to our utility customers during the COVID-19 pandemic, on April 13, 2020, the Gig Harbor City Council passed Ordinance No. 1443, which amends utility service charges for a limited duration. This emergency measure was taken to ensure that residents and businesses can afford utility services during a time where many are particularly vulnerable.

Ordinance No. 1443 removes the base rate from all water and sewer utility bills for one (1) two-month billing cycle between the months of March and May 2020. This means utility customers will receive this one-time rate reduction either on the March/April invoice or on the April/May invoice depending on the customer's billing cycle. The City's prudent management of our water-sewer utility allows us to offer short-term rate relief to our customers, and we believe it is the right thing to do.
